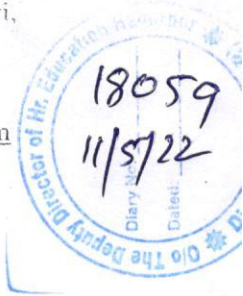

This is in reference to your application vide letter No: Nil, dated: 10/12/2019 received in this office on dated: 10/12/2019 on the subject cited above. In this regard it is informed that as per the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016 the responsibilities of collection centres are as under:

- (1) Collect E-waste on behalf of authorized recycler i.e. M/s Aptus Recycling Pvt. Ltd. Ashok Nagara, Malavalli Town Mandya Karnataka which has been authorized for generation/collection/storage/Dismantling/ recycling of E-Waste granted by Member Secretary, Karnataka State Pollution Control Board "Parisara Bhavan", #49, 4th & 5th Floor, Church Street, Bangalore-560001 vide letter No: PCB/192/E-Waste/2014/Reg. No. 114307/OB-945 dated: 17/12/2015 including those arising from orphaned products. Provided the collection centers established by producer can also collect e-waste on behalf of said recycler including those arising from orphaned products.
- (2) Ensure that the facilities are in accordance with the standards or guidelines issued by Central Pollution Control Board from time to time;
- (3) Ensure that the E-Waste collected by unit is stored in a secured manner till it is sent to authorized dismantler or recycler as the case may be;
- (4) Ensure that no damage is caused to the environment during storage and transportation of e-waste;
- (5) Maintain records in Form-2 of the e-waste handled as per the guidelines of Central Pollution Control Board and make such records available for scrutiny by the Central Pollution Control Board or the concerned State Pollution Control Board as and when asked for.

**PUBLIC NOTICE TO BULK CONSUMERS**  
**UNDER E-WASTE (MANAGEMENT) RULES, 2016**

Whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt. of India in exercise to powers conferred by Section 6, 8 and 25 of Environment Protection Act, 1986 and in supersession of E-Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 vide G.S.R. 338(E) dated 23.03.2016 formulated E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016. Whereas, these rules are applicable to every Manufacturer, Producer, Consumer, Bulk Consumer, Collection Centres, Dealers, E-retailer, Refurbisher, Dismantler and Recycler involved in manufacture, sale, transfer, purchase, collection, storage and processing of e-waste or electrical and electronic equipment listed in Schedule-I, including their components, consumables, parts and spares which make the product operational.

Whereas, under Section 3(c) of said rules, "Bulk Consumer" means bulk users of electrical and electronic equipment such as *Central Government or State Government Departments, public sector undertakings, banks, educational institutions, multinational organizations, international agencies, partnership and public or private companies* that are registered under the Factories Act, 1948 (63 of 1948) and the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013) and health care facilities which have turnover of more than one crore or have more than twenty employees.


Whereas, under Section 9(1), consumers or bulk consumers of electrical and electronic equipment listed in Schedule I shall ensure that e-waste generated by them is channelized through collection centre or dealer of authorized producer or dismantler or recycler or through collection centre or dealer of authorized producer or dismantler or recycler or through the designated take back service provider of the producer to authorized dismantler or recycler.

Further, all E-waste generated by bulk consumers, after end of life should be sold to only authorized E-waste collection centre, recycler, dismantler and refurbisher as per provision of E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016. List of E-waste items generated by the Bulk Consumers is mentioned in Schedule-I of E-waste (Management) Rules, 2016 and can be downloaded from the H.P. State Board website link <https://hppcb.nic.in/>.

Whereas, under Section 9(2) bulk consumers of electrical and electronic equipment listed in Schedule I shall maintain records of e-waste generated by them in Form 2 and make such records available for scrutiny by the concerned State Pollution Control Board.

Whereas, under Section 9(4) "Bulk Consumers" of electrical and electronic equipment listed in Schedule-I shall file annual returns in Form-3, to the concerned State Pollution Control Board on or before the 30th day of June following the financial year to which that return relates.

This is issued in greater interest of public and for compliance for the various provisions of E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016.
